Electronic Recycling- Michele Kocour has graciously offered to

manage this April 3rd thru the 7th. Below I am posting her instructions and she will also put flyers in the clubhouse. Thank you Michele!

We will be collecting electronics recyclables beginning Monday, April 3 through Friday, April 7, 2023. These items will be taken to the electronics recycling event held by the City of Scottsdale under the auspices of the Scottsdale Police Department. Here are lists of what you CAN and CANNOT recycle: **Acceptable items:**

- Computers/Peripherals: PC's, printers, keyboards, scanners, mice, flat panel monitors, circuit boards and hard drives
- Office Equipment: telephones, cell phones, answering machines, pagers, typewriters and calculators
- Entertainment Equipment: cameras, televisions, VCRs, DVRs, DVD players and stereo equipment

Prohibited items:

- CRT televisions and monitors, projection screen televisions
- Compact Fluorescent Lights (CFL) and Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Batteries
- Appliances: air conditioners, can openers, coffee pots, microwaves, stoves & ovens, refrigerators, washers & dryers and hot water heaters
- No commercial materials will be accepted

Drop-offs begin Monday, April 3, 2023 until 8 pm on Friday, April 7, 2023 residents may leave their items for recycling in Michele Kocour's carport located at **4920 North 78th Street**. Please leave items to the LEFT side of the carport on top of the sheets. Please do NOT block entrance to the home or ring the doorbell.

This is a great opportunity to de-clutter your home and recycle properly and safely. You are encouraged to tell your neighbors and family so we have as much as possible to recycle. If you have a neighbor who needs assistance getting the items to Michele's carport, please help them out or let Michele know of anyone needing assistance. We have great volunteers on this projects! Here is your chance to free up some space in your home!!

Once again, the City of Scottsdale and the Scottsdale Police oversee this event. It is a wonderful way to help the environment and to support the City's recycle efforts. It is a VERY SAFE way to get rid of your electronics.

A few strong people are needed to help load the items into vehicles, as some of the items are heavy and tough to load up. Access to a truck
